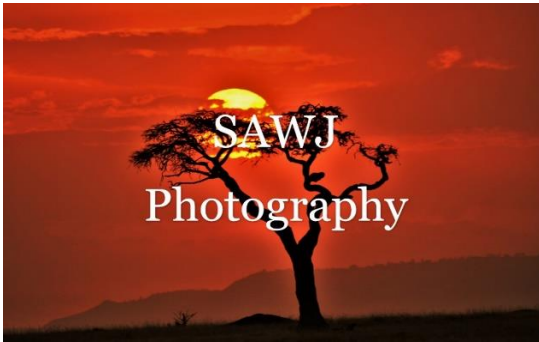
TWW Inc.'s art auctions are tax-deductible. All proceeds assist in providing:

Kenya 24 x 18: Ancestors:

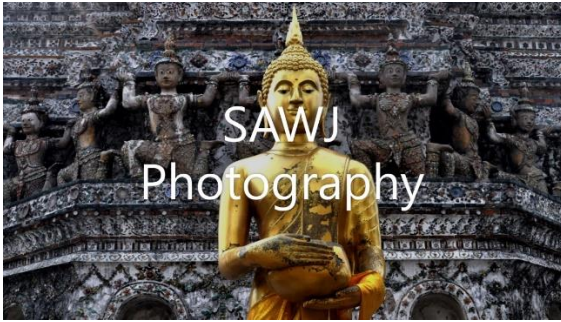

Botswana 22x 19: Husband and Wife

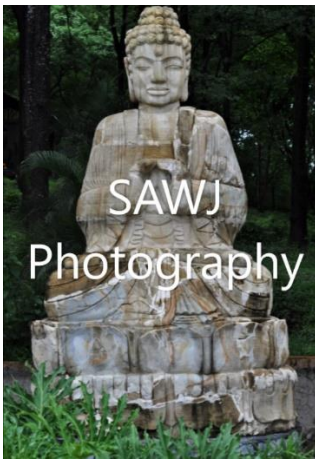


