6. That photo will be taken down from SAWJ photography website and will not be re-sold.

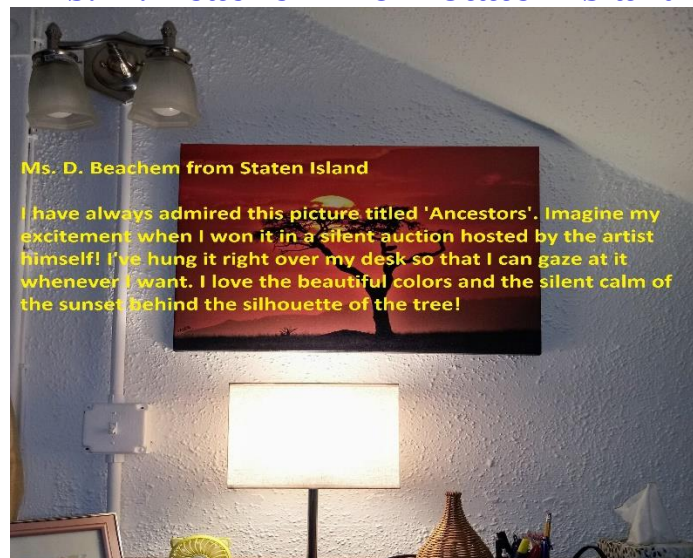


